LEMO RoHS Compliance Declaration

On 2nd January 2013, Directive 2002/95/EC is repealed by Directive 2011/65/EU known as the recast of the RoHS Directive or as the RoHS 2 Directive.

In 2015, Directive 2015/863, known as RoHS 3, was published by the EU expanding the scope of the actual Directive by adding 4 additional restricted substances (phthalates) to the existing list of 6.

This last Directive bans, as of 22nd July 2019, the introduction of products that contain an excess of allowable concentrations of now 10 identified hazardous chemicals:

| • | Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) | 0.1% |
| • | Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) | 0.1% |

Some exemptions listed in Annex III of Directive 2011/65/EU are applicable to LEMO products:

- 6(a) Lead as an alloying element in steel for machining purposes and in galvanised steel containing up to 0,35 % lead by weight.
- 6(c) Copper alloy containing up to 4 % lead by weight.

LEMO certifies that connectors and accessories produced and supplied under the brands LEMO, REDEL and COELVER are compliant with 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU of the European Parliament.
